

**Keene** Charles Thomas

Military record – Attested 28/12/1914, of Kingscourt, age 37, single, circular sawyer.

Glos Rgt 17294. (He enlisted the day before Mitchell and Stevens of Kingscourt – only 10 service numbers apart)

Served in France, wounded in 1916 and 1917.

20/05/1916 – absent from returning leave in England – about 11 hours – severe reprimand and forfeit of 2 days pay.

Discharged Jan 1919.

*Married Laura Clark of Locking Hill, Stroud in Middlesbrough July 1915 and shortly leaving for the front. Parents now have 4 sons serving*
